SAU1 Board members are volunteers.

Every Board member starts as "Shadow" who

- takes part in all Board calls and meetings,
- shares their opinion, ideas, and views, and
- learns from and teaches others about being on a Board

Shadow time is a way for a person to get to know SAU1 and for the Board to get to know them.

Shadow members may be elected to the Board after a few months, when the person and the Board think it is a good match.

Full Board members vote on important things for SAU1.

Relatives of SAU1 staff cannot be board members.

What is a Board meeting like?

Our board meets almost every week.

We meet over google meet.

Some join by computer and some by phone.

We follow our ground rules:

- Take Care of yourself.
- Show respect for others.
- All questions are good.
